

**New regulation on pre-registration and test requirements for persons entering Germany –  
Partial exemptions from pre-registration and negative Covid-19 tests in Germany**

| <b>Pre-registration</b>                                    | <b>Exemptions:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Persons who have only passed through a risk area and have not had a stopover there.,</li> <li>Persons who have stayed in a risk area for less than 24 hours or who enter the Federal Republic of Germany for up to 24 hours in the context of border traffic,</li> <li>Persons that are performing, in a professional context, border crossing transports of goods</li> </ul>   | <b>Exemptions:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Persons who have only passed through a risk area and have not had a stopover there.,</li> <li>Persons who have stayed in a risk area for less than 24 hours or who enter the Federal Republic of Germany for up to 24 hours in the context of border traffic,</li> </ul>  | <b>No exemptions</b>  |
| <b>Negative Covid-19 test</b>                              | <p>Test may be performed up to max. 48 h <u>after</u> entry and must be presented in either German, English, or French</p> <b>Exemptions:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Persons who have only passed through a risk area and have not had a stopover there.,</li> <li>Persons who have stayed in a risk area for less than 24 hours or who enter the Federal Republic of Germany for up to 24 hours in the context of border traffic,</li> <li>Persons that are performing, in a professional context, border crossing transports of goods</li> <li>Cross-border commuters who return to their place of residence at least once a week.</li> </ul> | <p>Test may be max. 48 h old upon entry and must be presented at entry upon request in either German, English, or French</p> <b>Exemptions:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Persons who have only passed through a high incidence area and have not had a stopover there,</li> <li>Persons that are performing, in a professional context, border crossing transports of goods and have been in a high incidence area for less than 72 hours.</li> </ul> | <p>Test may be max. 48 h old upon entry and must be presented at entry upon request in either German, English, or French</p> <b>No exemptions</b> |
